

"I had been thinking about it for a while. Maybe, through Facebook it was easier for me to relate to other people. What if I became someone else, with a fake name? It would be like starting from scratch — at least online. At the time I reckoned it was a brilliant idea, but now I think about what I did and see it like it really was: absolute stupidity."
