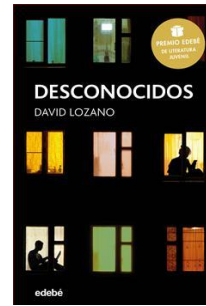
NEBBIA, NÚRIA PRADAS/ 312 PP

Nebbia is a Gothic novel set in the fascinating Venice of the 18th century. A mysterious oath hides the secrets that torture Goia's soul with sharp and painful letters. The fact is that the conundrums the young woman has inherited from her mother — who, just before dying, entrusted her to a dear sister who lives in Venice — are numerous.

That's how Nebbia takes us into this fascinating city of the 18th century, playful and carnival, but that hides at the same time dark and threatening corners. In fact, in aunt Gertrude's radiant mansion, where Goia moves into, luxury is mixed with a terrible feeling, a deep sadness that comes with ominous forebodings.

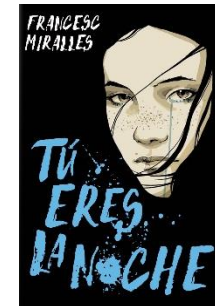

What would happen to you if you never again saw the light of the sun?

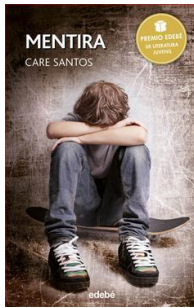
