A novel full of hope in one of the most difficult times in history. A radiography of the human being.




A journey through the happiest and unknown days of Federico García Lorca in the golden Cuba of 1930

He is the author of a dozen books on journalism and four novels: *El Cátaro imperfecto* (2013), *Amor contra Roma* (2014), *La hija del capitán Groc* (Ramon Llull Award 2016) and *Yo pude salvar a Lorca* (2018). His love for Federico García Lorca has led him to explore the poet's vital epiphany in 1930's Cuba, and the result is his fifth novel: *Si yo me pierdo* (2022).





This book opens a novelistic cycle with the author's native Pallars as a point of reference, which also includes *Mel i metzines* (1990) and *Cánfora* (Critics' Prize 1992, Critics' Prize Serra d'Or 1993 and National Literature Prize 1993). Her work as a novelist also includes the relevant titles *Escrivia cartes al cel* (1996), *Carrer Bolívia* (1999), *Bella edat* (2003), *País íntim* (Prudenci Bertrana Award 2005), and *Emma* (2008). After her brilliant debut as a narrative author with *La mort de Teresa* (1986), she has published the volumes of short stories *Ulleres de sol* (1994), *La pressa del temps* (2009) and *Cada dia penso en tu* (2011). In 2014 she published the novel *En la pell de l'altre*, about the protagonist's ability to shine on a lie, and in 2019 *A l'amic escocès*, the work that closes the so-called *Ciclo del Pallars*. In 2021 she won the Josep Pla Prize with the novel *Tàndem* and the Prize of Honor of the Catalan Letters for her literary career.


Based on a real story: suicides avoided by a lonely man who transforms lives.

On his way to scatter his late brother's ashes, Tony happens to meet Kosei San, an old Japanese man living out his retirement days in a rustic, solitary cabin by the edge of a cliff. But Kosei San is not at rest. His attention does not stray for long from the steep rock face battered by the wind.
